**Name of Activity: Find Someone Who...**

**Target learners: 5th Graders**

**Time required: 40 minutes**

### **Aims**

As a warm-up for students to get to know each other  
Review the vocabulary and sentence patterns students learned before

### **Materials required & pre-lesson preparation**

Bingo worksheet  
Blank paper, markers  
Letter cards

### **In class procedure**

- Each student gets a piece of paper to write down his/her English name
- Each student introduces himself/herself to his/her partner.
- Each student writes down three things about himself/herself, e.g. blue, hamburger, 5. In a pair, student finds out what the three things of his/her partner are.
- Set a time limit of 3 minutes, students go around and find out what the other students' three things are.
- Teacher shows the letter card, students whose names start with that letter stand up and say their names.
- Teacher distributes Bingo worksheet. Teacher elicits the answers of each question from the students. For example, can you play baseball? Do you like fish?
- Teacher explains the rules in four simple steps.  
A. Teacher asks questions B. Students whose answer to the question is yes write down their names C. Students draw a line D. Students who get two lines shout "Bingo"

### **Follow up**

Each student makes five sentences from the Bingo worksheet.  
For example, Mindy can play baseball. Roger has two sisters.
