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Name of Activity: Who's got what? ----Fruits

Target learners: 3rd graders

Time required: 40 mins

Aims

To help students get familiar with the name of the fruits Apple, kiwi, orange, papaya, banana
Pass, take

Materials required & pre-lesson preparation

Record the sound for the game first according to the target words.
MP3 players.
Word cards. Picture cards.

In class procedure

Warm up (5 mins)

Ask students about the fruits they like and also discuss the benefits of eating fruit.

Presentation(30 mins)

1. Use flash cards to teach kids the new vocabulary. (5 mins)
2. Assign each line a kind of fruit. When they ask the teacher "What do you like?" The teacher will say the name of a fruit. "I like _____." And the line representing the fruit will have to stand up. (10mins)
3. teach them the pattern of " pass....to..." and "take....."(5mins)
4. Start with the game "Who got what?"(10mins)
 - (1) Assign each kid in the group a number from 1 to 4.
 - (2) Demonstrate how to play the game and what the kids have to do in the game.
 - (3) Start to play the sound "Who's got what?"

Wrap up (5mins)

Check whether individual students can say the word or not.

Follow up

In the next class, teach the kids the verbs such as "chop up, peel, toss, add..." and make a book about making fruit salad.
