Students will work in groups. Students will have to use a secret code to figure out the answers to clues to unlock every piece of their puzzle. Each group will be given two sheets of paper. One of the sheets will have 6 clues for students to follow in order to complete their puzzle. The other one will have the key for the secret code.</li> <li>2. There will be between 4-6 students per group.</li> <li>3. To follow the clue, students must find clue cards. On each clue card there will be a secret code for each clue. Each clue will describe the color and taste of a fruit or food. Those items will be revealed in the puzzles. The clues will not be in the correct order. Students however, must complete the clues in the correct order. They must search until they find the clue card</li> </ol>		<p><b>20 min</b></p>	

	<p>that has their first, then second, then third, and so forth. When they solve clue number one, they must come back to the start to collect their first piece of their puzzle. To collect the first piece of the puzzle students must read the clue out loud.</p> <p>The first team to complete the puzzle wins a prize.</p>
