

Summer Camp lesson #2 - 2019

Camp Theme: Wonderful World of Water

Name: Darcy Lopez

Lesson Topic: Different layers in the ocean and types of animals living in those levels. Main focus, midnight level and the strange creatures that live there.

Lesson Objective: Students will learn about different levels in the ocean and its inhabitants.

Target Language: Students will be able to identify levels in the ocean and animals.

Lesson vocab-levels of the ocean: sunlight zone (sharks, sea turtle, seals) Twilight zone (crab, whales, octopus), Midnight zone (eel, anglerfish, lantern fish, giant spider crab),

Materials Needed: whiteboards and poster board

Hook: poster board

Presentation: PPT explaining the different levels in the ocean and how each layer is defined by the amount of sunlight that enters that zone. Will also introduce animals that inhabit those zones.

Practice: memory game- will use PPT to implement game. Each slide will have 4 pics. Students will have 10 seconds to memorize all pics shown. One will disappear and students have to write the missing word for the pic. Will give points for students with correct answers.

Production: poster board- students will draw out the layers of the ocean and will draw an animal that lives in that zone. Will provide a demonstration and word banks,

Wrap Up: Award marbles accordingly and dismiss.
