

Your Task

1. Discuss with your co-teacher and decide on a topic appropriate for your target learners' grade level.
2. Choose 12 key words related to the topic and give each word a definition or description.
(i.e., **Triangle**: a plane figure with three straight sides and three angles.)
3. Write the 12 key words on the board. Cut out the sentences into strips and put them into a box.
4. Prepare Bingo sheets with a 3*3 grid on it. Give each student a Bingo sheet.
5. You are about to explain this activity "Bingo" to your students:

- (1) Students get to choose 9 out of 12 words and randomly fill them into the 3*3 grid on the Bingo sheet.
- (2) The instructor randomly picks a strip out of the box and calls out the definition without naming the word itself. Tell students to listen attentively and cross out the word if there's a match.
- (3) Students with a completed card shouts "BINGO!"
- (4) The instructor checks with students to see if the words are crossed out correctly.
- (5) The activity continues until more students shout out.

6. Apply the "Team-Teaching" model while giving the instructions. Both teachers should share teaching responsibilities.
7. Practice co-teaching and rehearse before you go onto the stage.
