

Your Task

1. Discuss with your co-teacher and decide two topics appropriate for your target learners' grade level.
2. Choose 10 words related to each topic. Prepare 20 cards and write each word on a separate card.
3. You are about to explain this activity "*Guess the Word*" to your students:

- (1) Put the 10 cards (from the same topic) upside down in a pile.
- (2) Divide the class into two teams, A and B.
- (3) Ask a student from Team A to pick a card and draw it (or act it out) for their team.
- (4) Team A must try to guess the word being drawn (or acted out). When they have guessed the word, the student from Team A picks a new card and continues.
- (5) Set a timer. The team has one minute to guess as many words as possible. Each word guessed correctly is one point. However, if both teams guess all the words correctly before time's up, then the fastest team wins.
- (6) After one minute, it's Team B's turn. Put the other 10 cards upside down in a pile, and ask a student from Team B to pick the cards.

4. Apply the "Team Teaching" model while giving instructions. Both teachers should share teaching responsibilities.
5. Practice co-teaching and rehearse before you go onto the stage.
