Show the slides of rhythm names, ta and ti-ti.</li> <li>3. Have the Ss clap and say the rhythm names.</li> <li>4. Place rhythm flashcards around the classroom.</li> <li>5. Play the hand drum following the rhythm. Ask the Ss to listen and move to the corresponding rhythm flashcard.</li> <li>6. Have the Ss return to their seats.</li> <li>7. Distribute two rhythm cards to each S.</li> <li>8. Play the wood block and have the Ss place the rhythm cards on the desk according to what they heard.</li> <li>9. 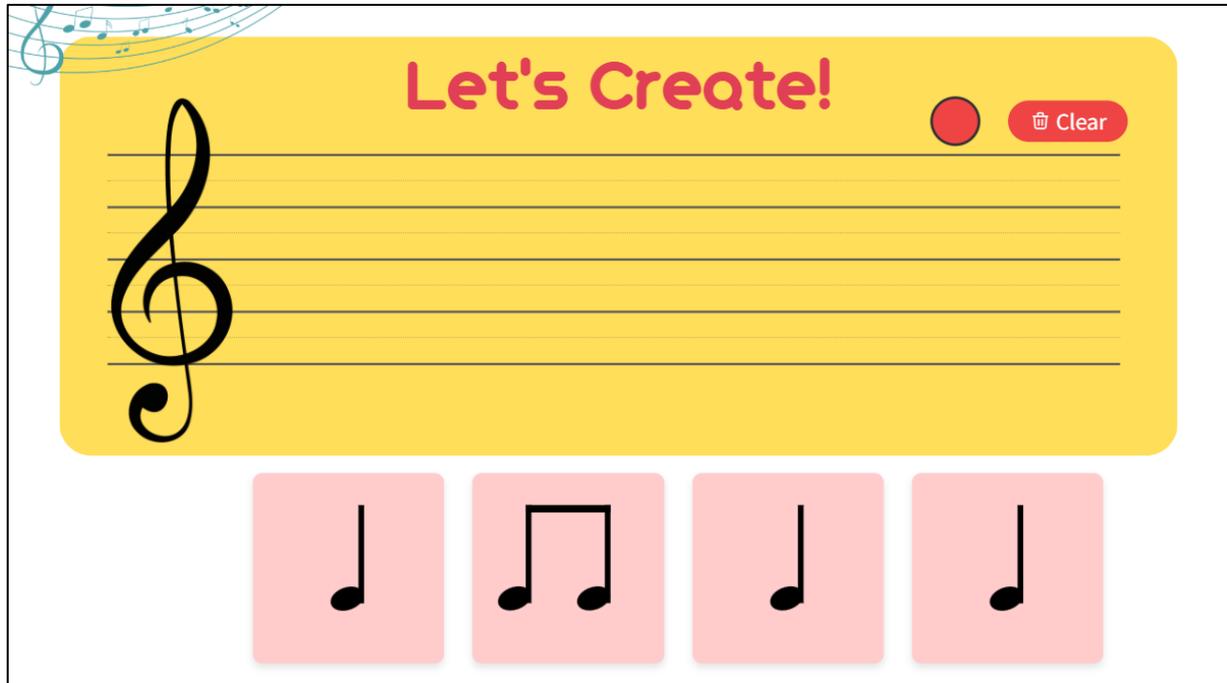

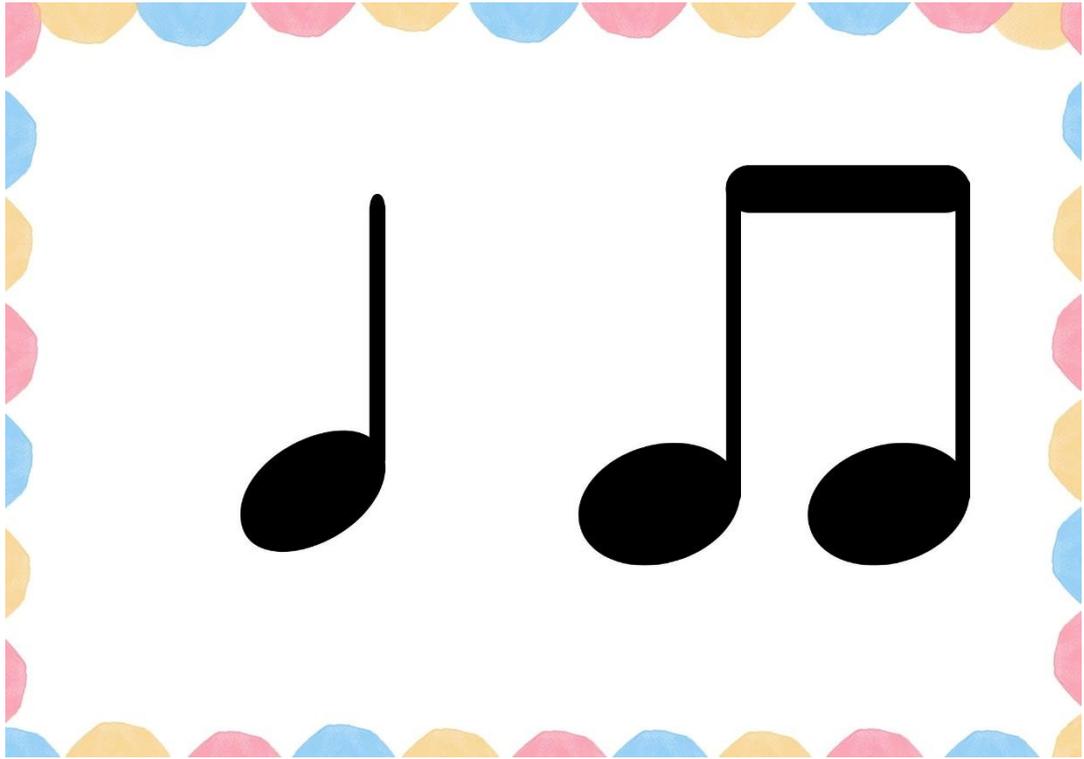
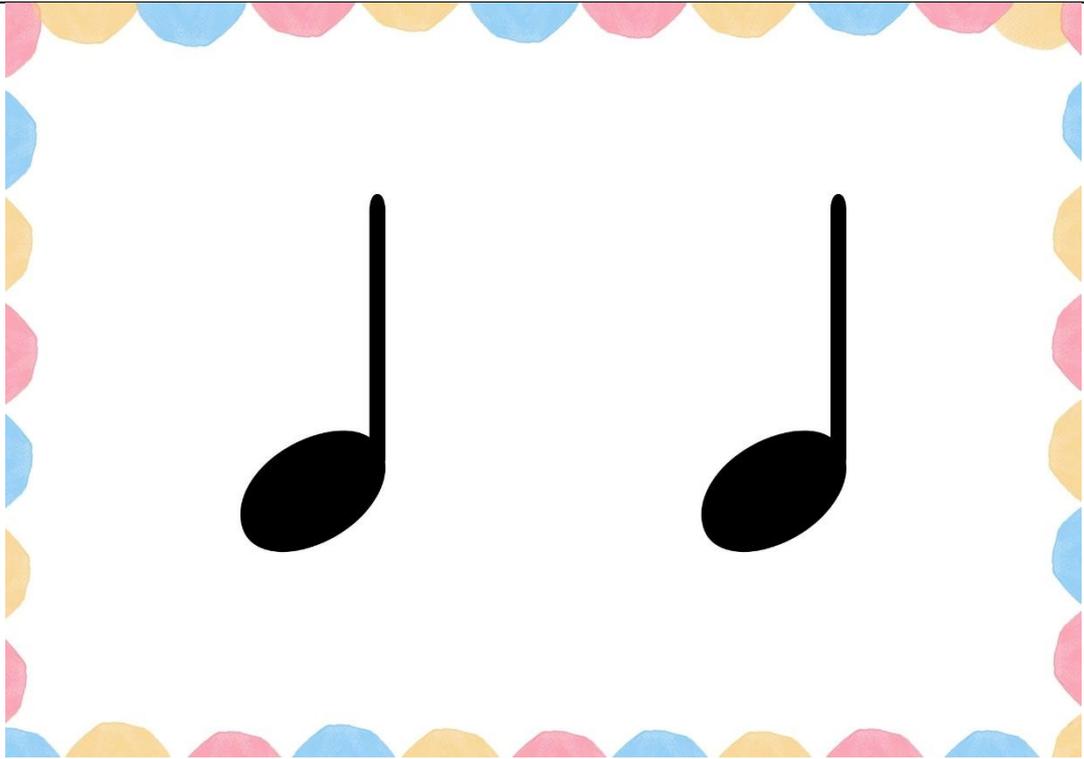
